1. Opening remarks by the Chancellor.

The Chancellor welcomed all the members to the 20th Board of Management meeting. This meeting has been called for passing the resolution for the award of Degree of Doctor of Science (Honoris Causa) to two eminent personalities and also the award of degrees of Ph.D., M.Phil., Postgraduate, Undergraduate and Diploma during the 9th Convocation to be held hereafter. The students completed the courses successfully will be awarded degrees during this Convocation. Dr. E. Sreedharan, who has been nominated for the award of Honoris Causa during this Convocation is unfortunately hospitalized due to his ill health and he is unable to attend the Convocation.

2. Address by the Vice Chancellor.

5. Award of Honoris Causa to eminent personalities.

(i) The Vice Chancellor moved the following resolution: -

(ii) The Vice Chancellor moved the following resolution: -

7. Organization of “Second International Conference on Sustainable Environment and Energy (ICSEE2019)”.

The Department of Civil Engineering, HITS submitted application to Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB), Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India to organize “Second International Conference on Sustainable Environment and Energy (ICSEE2018)”. The SERB, DST has sanctioned a sum of Rs.2 lakhs as partial grant-in-aid to HITS to organize the same. As per the SERB conditions, we have to execute a Bond to receive the funds. One of the conditions in the bond is that a resolution as stated below has to be approved by the Board of Management.

Hence the following resolution was moved by the Vice Chancellor for approval of the Board of Management:

“It is resolved to receive a sum of Rs.2 lakhs as partial grant-in-aid sanctioned by the Science and Engineering Research Board, Department of Science and Technology, Government of India to organize the ‘Second International Conference on Sustainable Environment and Energy’ on 21-22, February 2019 by the Department of Civil Engineering.”

Approved by the BOM.

8. Establishment of School of Law:

The Vice Chancellor placed before the Board of Management, the proposal of establishing **School of Law** in the Hindustan Institute of Technology and Science, from the academic year 2019-2020 with the approval of Bar Council of India. The Vice Chancellor further moved to seek approval from the Board of Management, for the appointment of Dean and other required faculty members, constitution of the Board of Studies for School of Law and preparation of Academic Regulations, curriculum and syllabi for the programmes, to be offered from the academic year 2019-2020.

The Vice Chancellor also moved to seek approval for the following intake for the programmes under the School of Law:

The above proposal of establishing School of Law with the recognition of Bar Council of India and creating required facilities together with in-take of 60 (Sixty only) students each for B.A.LL.B. (Hons.), B.B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) and LL.B. is approved.

9. Any other item with the permission of the Chair.

- (a) Prof. P.J. Kurien informed that 4th India International Science Festival (IISF) 2018 is being organized by the Ministry of Science and Technology, Ministry of Earth Sciences in association with Vijnana Bharati at Indira Gandhi Pratishthan, Lucknow during 5-8 October, 2018. He suggested HITS staff and students to actively participate in the Science Festival.
- (b) The Vice Chancellor submitted a Brief Report on new initiatives taken since 1st March 2018 to the members and invited suggestions, if any, from the members. He highlighted the following new initiatives: -
 - (i) Fee for all full time research scholars has been reduced to Rs. 30,000/- per year to enhance Full-Time Ph.D. registrations.

- (ii) The ERP and Learning Management System (LMS) is under implementation. The faculty members are given training to the ERP and Learning Management System.
- (iii) Research at Undergraduate Level. In order to bring research at Undergraduate level, the HITS has hired the services of the agency, M/s CL Educate Ltd. to guide and motivate the undergraduate students to involve in the live projects. He informed that a project named “JAIHIND - 1S” which is an experimental satellite developed by the students of first year Aeronautical Engineering which weighs only 33.39 grams (“lightest micro satellite” awarded by India book of records) has been launched successfully on 9th September 2018 by NASA at Columbia Scientific Balloon Facility. The Board congratulated the students on their unique achievement and wished many more such projects to emerge from the University in the days to come.

The meeting concluded with vote of thanks by the Chairperson of the meeting.
