The staff and management of Hindustan Group of Institutions (HGI) contributed Rs. 50 Lakhs towards the "Tamil Nadu CM Relief Fund", through Dr. K. C. G. Verghese Charitable Foundation. On behalf of the Foundation, the cheque was handed over to the Hon'ble Tamil Nadu CM, M.K. During this pandemic, HGI jointly with Dr. K. C. G. Verghese Charitable Foundation contributed Rs 1.3 crores to the upliftment of the society by involving in relief activities. Hindustan Covid relief efforts reached out to over 5000 families by distributing essential groceries and medical kits. The camps were set-up at various villages including Illalur, Kayar, Vembedu, Idayankuppam, Thirupporur, Padur, Kelambakkam, Pudupakkam, Neelangarai and Injambakkam, Chennai, and all Chengalpattu District.



It facilitates remote communication between medical frontline workers and quarantined patient through Video/Audio.







Owing to the state-wide lockdown and the extensive vaccination drives carried out by the Tamil Nadu Government, the recent weeks have seen a rapid fall in the number of Covid cases in Tamil Nadu. The Chennai Corporation is also conducting numerous vaccination drives to administer as many vaccination doses as possible to locally curb the spread of the Covid-19 virus in Chennai.
