This is an optional task and the clubs are free to choose either of the two above tasks or both as they wish.*

4) Common Display Picture

A common Display picture will be created and circulated by us that all the participating clubs would be required to keep on their social media handles on October 2nd.

It was also required and requested that in all the club's social media posts related to PROJECT 152, our district's social media handles are tagged (given below) along with the hashtag #ROTARACT152

Out of the 118 clubs, around 80 clubs completed all the three task and 20 Clubs completed 2 task and rest have completed one task! Their impact on people is immeasurable and it fulfills the core principle of Rotaract, Fellowship through Service. This event was commended by multiple district International Service Directors and District Rotaract Representatives. The principal objective of the event was to spread the message of non-violence and service to the needy on the birth anniversary of the person whose name has become synonymous with peace. The feeling of gratitude on knowing that people are getting benefited directly and indirectly through our work is unfathomable.
