Round - 1 (Pre-Qualifying Round)

- * The choir can perform any one christmas carol of their choice, in unison or four parts
- * Choir must consist of atleast 06 to a maximum of 30 members
- * Pre-recorded tracks (inclusive of styles in keyboard) are not allowed
- * Maximum time limit is 4 mins.
- * Unedited video of the live performance should be recorded and sent in mp4 format to the e-mail id
- * Video must have date stamp.
- * Last date of receipt of video is 30th november 2022.
- * Shortlisted teams shall be notified through e-mail
- * All rights of the video shall be reserved to Hindustan Institute of Technology and Science

Round - 2 (Qualifying Round)

- * Teams short-listed from round 1 should perform the song given by the organizers. The score sheet for the same shall be provided.
- * Team members must remain the same for both round 1 and round 2.
- * Compulsory song must be performed a capella
- * Maximum time limit is 4 mins.
- * Unedited video of the live performance should be recorded and sent in mp4 format to the e-mail id.
- * Video must have date stamp.
- * Last date of receipt of video is 9th december 2021
- * Shortlisted teams shall be notified through e-mail
- * Judges decision will be final.

Round - 3 Finals

- * The teams selected from round 2 shall be notified through e-mail.
- * Finals will be conducted at the hindustan institute of technology and science campus, padur on 16th december 2022.
- * All selected choir members must be present at our campus on the above said date. If the teams doesn't report on time, will be disqualified for the final round and will not be allowed to participate.
- * Teams must perform two songs, out of which one must be the compulsory song that was performed in round 2.
- * Teams must provide full score of the song they perform on stage.
- * Maximum time limit is 10 mins (8 mins for performance, 2 mins for preparation)
- * Pre-recorded tracks (inclusive of styles in keyboard) are not allowed
- * Team members must remain the same as in round 1 and round 2.
- * Judges decision will be final.
